Calling players for master class on November 15, 2010

For a complete listing of requirements see http://www.agohq.org/docs/ pdf/ProfCertRequirements.pdf The Service Playing Test is recorded between October and April. The requirements include playing three short pieces, transposition (not at sight), play two hymns, accompany two anthems and a psalm, sight-read from two staves. The music is arranged like playing for a service of worship. Prelude Opening Hymn Psalm Accompaniment Anthem Accompaniment Middle Hymn Second Anthem Offertory Repertoire Sight-reading Closing Hymn Postlude Repertoire.

An example of the Sight-reading from AGOHQ will be available at the meeting in addition to 100 Strategies for Successful AGO Certification.
